

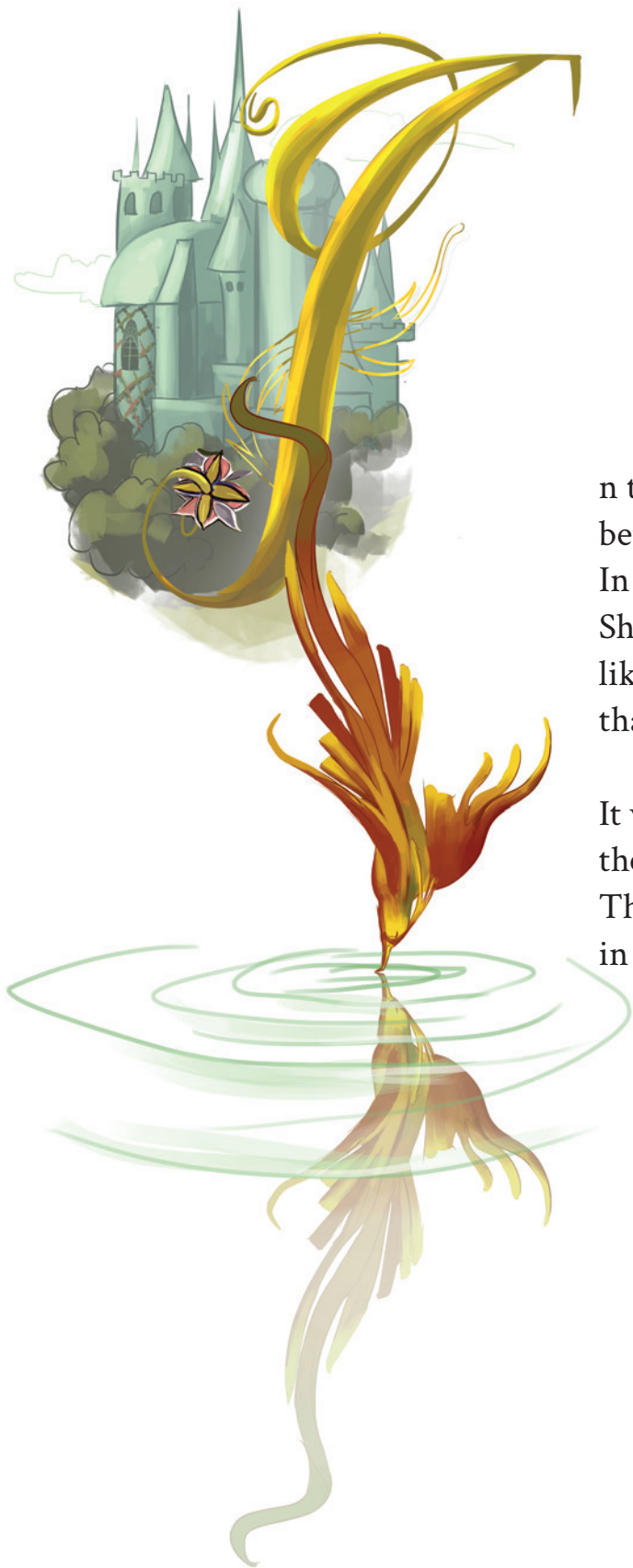


This Book Belongs To,

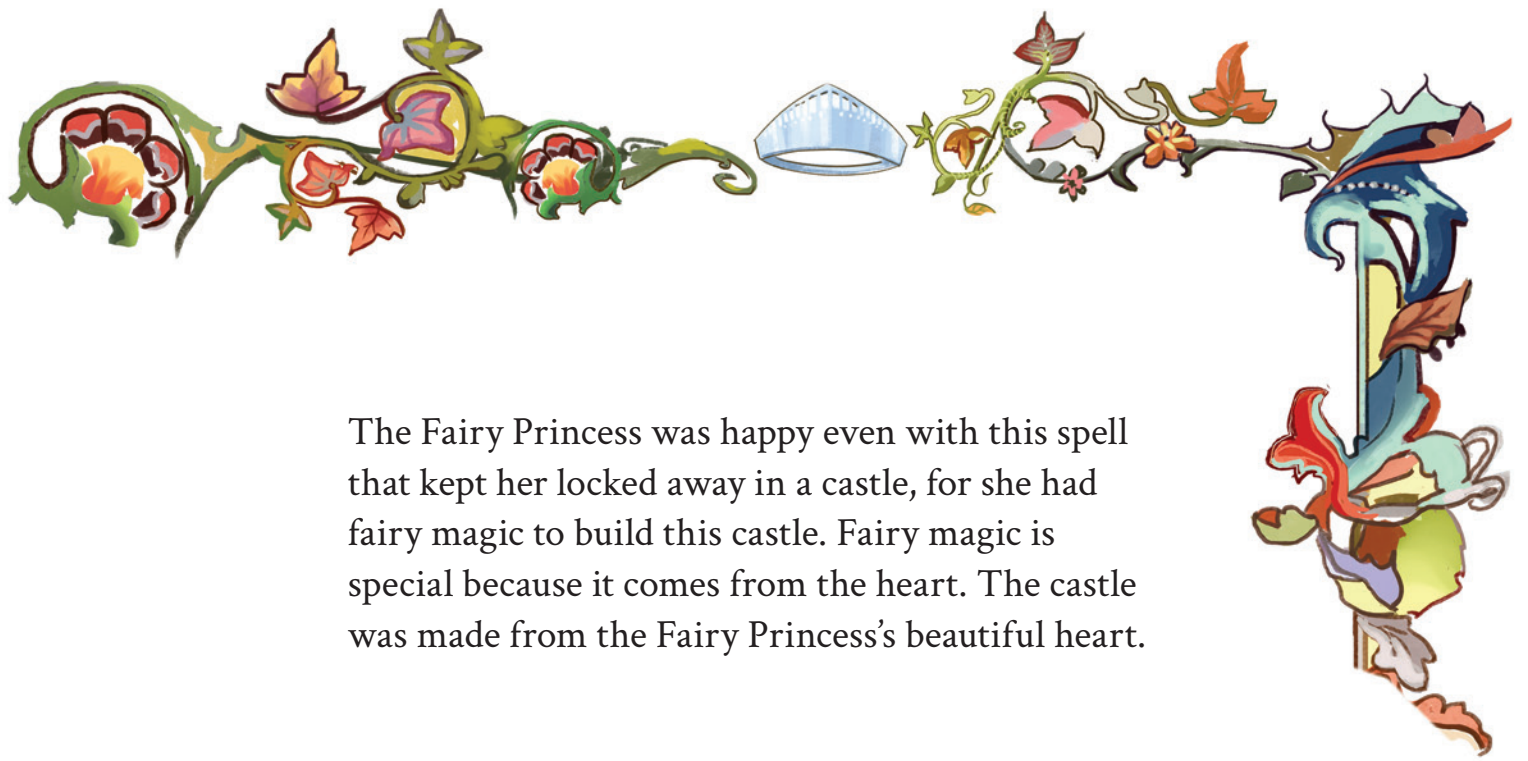
*My wings are the color of a Rainbow

wings always sing on the whisper of your Truth*





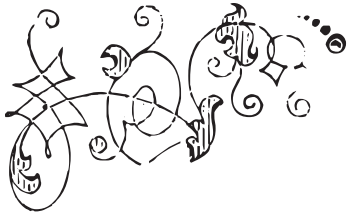

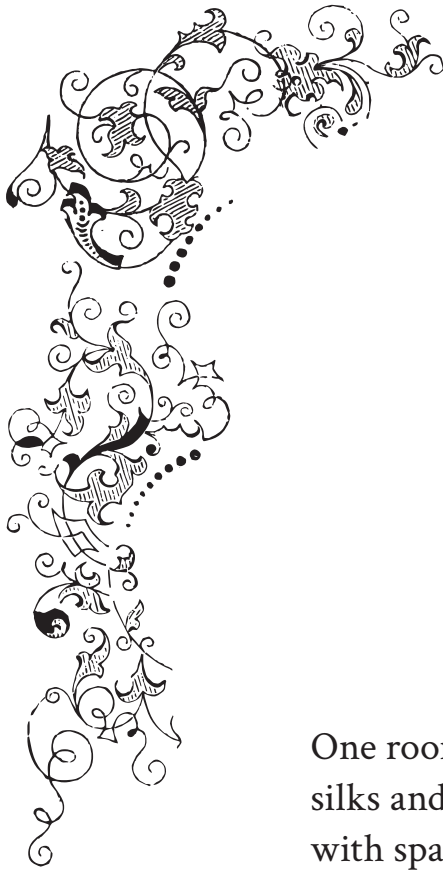
